<b>325. DRESS AND GROOMING</b>	
1. Authority	<p><b>Administrative, professional and support</b> employees set an example in dress and grooming for students <b>and the school community. Employees' dress should reflect their professional status</b> and encourage respect for authority in <b>order to have</b> a positive <b>influence on</b> the <b>district's</b> programs and operations.</p>
SC 510	<p>The Board has the authority to specify reasonable dress and grooming <b>requirements, within law, for all district employees to</b> prevent an adverse impact on the educational <b>programs and district operations.</b></p> <p>When assigned to district duties, employees shall be physically clean, neat, well-groomed and dressed in a manner <b>consistent with assigned job responsibilities. Staff should not be in violation of the student dress code.</b></p>
2. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>If an employee feels that an exception to this policy would enable him/her to carry out assigned duties more effectively, a request should be made to the <b>immediate supervisor.</b></p>
