PSERS sets contribution rate.

The Pennsylvania Public School Employees' Retirement System Board of Trustees met on December 12 to certify the new employer contribution rate for fiscal year 2009-10. Effective July 1, 2009, the total employer contribution rate will be 4.78%. This is a slight increase from the current rate of 4.76%. The 4.78% employer contribution rate is composed of 0.78% for health insurance premium assistance and a pension rate of 4%. PSERS' funded ratio increased from 85.8% to 87.9% due to funding methodologies and previous investment gains.

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The board acknowledged that the large increase projected in FY 2012-13 is quickly approaching. PSERS also cautioned that, while the latest actuarial figures support only a small increase in the contribution rate, school employers should continue to prepare for the dramatic employer contribution rate increase forecast in four years. Revised projections provided by the fund's actuaries, Buck Consultants, show an increase in the FY 2012-13 rate spike from 11.23% to 16.40%.
